

Amgen Scholars Program: Code of Conduct

During your participation as an Amgen Scholar, you must comply with all applicable ETH Zurich policies and procedures. You will receive further information about ETH Zurich policies and procedures during your host institution's Amgen Scholars Program orientation.

Your behavior in the lab and outside the lab, at academic and social events, and at the regional symposium reflects not only upon you, but also on your home and summer program institutions, and the Amgen Foundation. ETH Zurich and the Amgen Foundation therefore expect you to treat your peers, supervisors, members of the community, and the public with consideration and respect. In addition, ETH Zurich and the Amgen Foundation require you to act responsibly in residential housing facilities provided by ETH Zurich for the Amgen Scholars Program as well as those provided for the regional symposium, whether you are a resident or a guest in any housing accommodation. You are further expected to abide by all local, state, and federal laws, including those prohibiting persons under legal age from consuming alcoholic beverages, driving while intoxicated, and using, possessing, or trafficking illegal drugs.

You are expected by ETH Zurich and the Amgen Foundation to participate fully in scheduled programming for the duration of the symposium and are not permitted to leave the symposium site without acknowledgment and the expressed permission of your institutional coordinator.

If ETH Zurich and/or the Amgen Foundation determine that a Scholar has acted in an unprofessional or irresponsible manner or has exercised poor judgment in a way that reflects negatively on ETH Zurich or the Amgen Foundation, appropriate disciplinary measures will be considered, up to and including immediate termination from the program. At ETH Zurich, the standard disciplinary process will be followed in accordance with applicable campus policies and procedures.
